## ABOUT

Queen Victoria Market is more than just Melbourne's shopping mecca - it's an historic landmark, a tourist attraction and an institution for Melburnians. This vast, vibrant centre of trade and commerce was officially opened on 20 March, 1878 and has served consumers' needs for more than 125 years.

Last year, the Market attracted over 9.5 million visitors.

Spread over 7 hectares, it's the largest open air market in the southern hemisphere. As Queen Victoria Market is a traditional open-air market, it's recommended that warm weatherproof clothing (in winter) will make your visit more enjoyable. Please note that dogs are not permitted. Almost one thousand traders sell everything from exotic Australian fruit and vegetables and local and imported gourmet foods, meat, fish and poultry, to hardware, manchester, clothing and authentic Australian artefacts and souvenirs.

Many traders are second- and third-generation, truly reflecting the cosmopolitan make-up of Melbourne.

## GETTING THERE

### **By Tram:**

Catch any tram heading north along Elizabeth and William Streets, and alight at either the Franklin or Victoria Street corners. Melbourne's free City Circle tram will also help you on your way. Hop off at the corner of La Trobe and either Elizabeth or Queen Streets, then walk north to the Market.

## ABOUT

Lygon Street is one of the great food precincts of Melbourne. It has its origins in the early immigration of Italian migrants to Melbourne and, in particular, to Carlton. It also owes much of its growth and popularity as a eating out destination to the students from Melbourne University, who frequented the street long before it became fashionable with business people.

Lygon Street has the biggest selection of Italian restaurants and cafes of anywhere in Australia, and was the first suburb in Melbourne to promote eating outdoors and tables and chairs on footpaths. Lygon Street is a great place to spend a warm summer's evening with a group of friends, especially if you're sitting in the garden cafe of one of the terraces that line the street.

## GETTING THERE

### **By Road:**

If you head straight up Russell St from the city it runs straight into Lygon St. The restaurant precinct starts at 1 Lygon St and extends through to about 340 or so, and there are about 100 places to eat from which to choose.

### **By Tram:**

The following tram routes stop at the corner of Elgin & Lygon Streets:

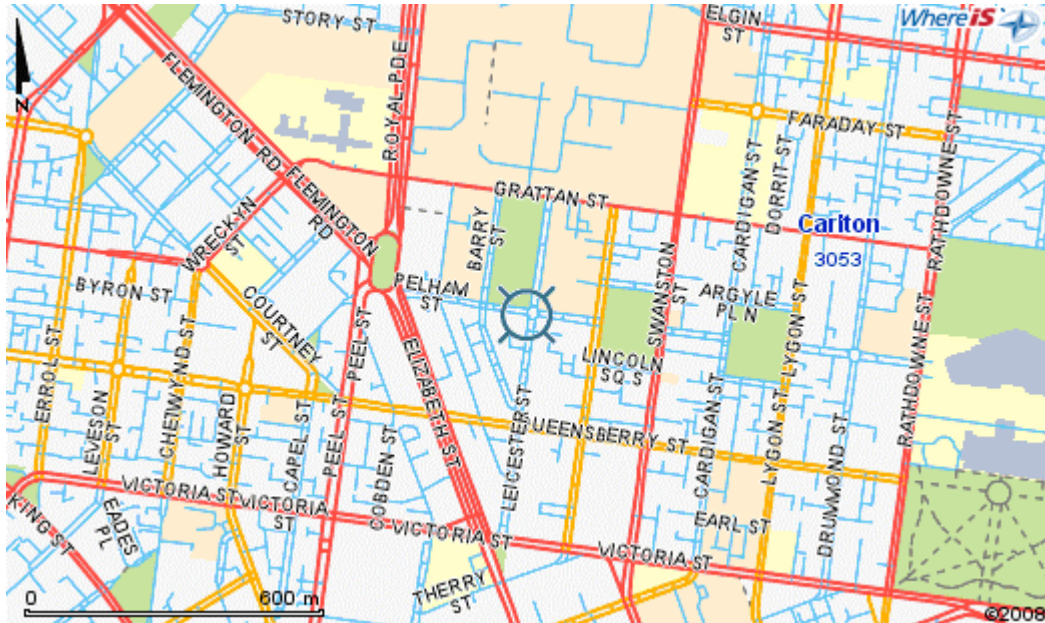

## TRAMS

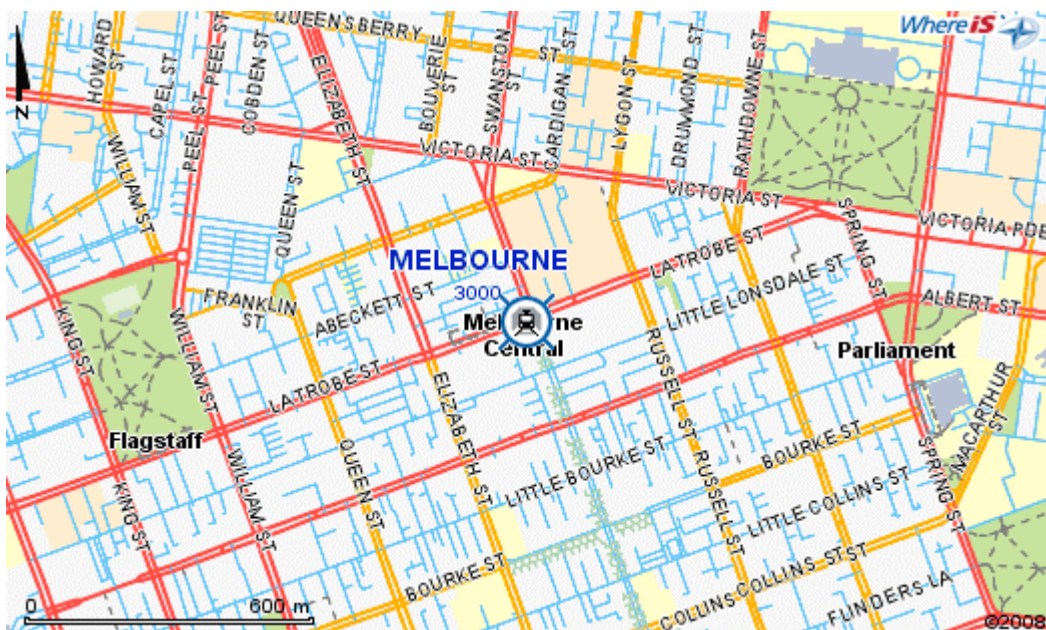
From the city:

- Tram 19 or 59 will bring you up Elizabeth Street. You will need to get off at the corner of Pelham & Elizabeth Street, Stop No. 9 and then walk down to 185 Pelham Street.
- Tram 1, 3, 5, 6, 8, 16, 22, 64, 67 or 72 will bring you up Swanston Street. You will need to get off at Lincoln Square, Stop No. 3 and then walk across the square to 185 Pelham Street.



## TRAINS

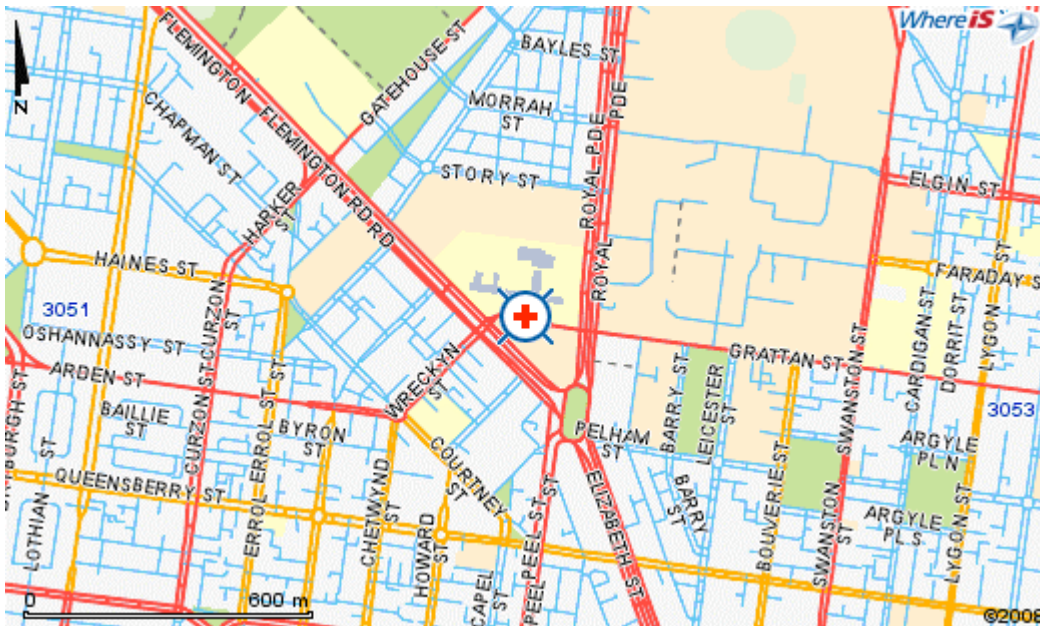
The nearest train station is Melbourne Central. It is located underneath the Melbourne Central Shopping Centre. See page 2 for details on how to get there.



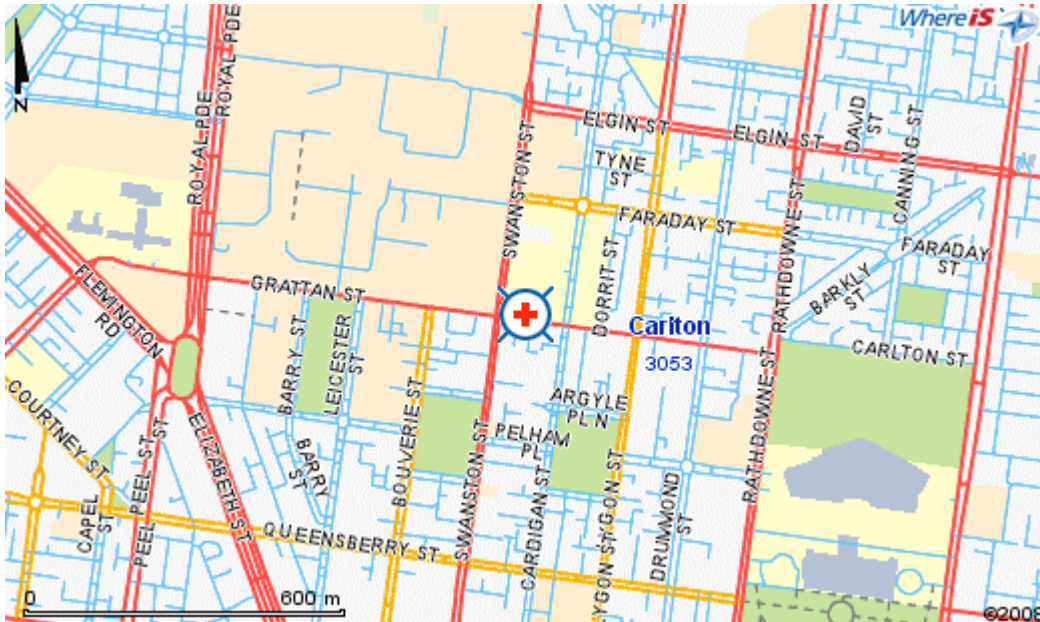
## TAXIS
